Along with this chapter, you will be reading select stories from *Famous Men of Rome*. It is a series of very interesting biographies. You will also use the *Famous Men of Rome Student Guide* from Memoria Press.

What to do:

Each week, you will read from the *All Ye Lands* textbook and take notes. Then, you will read two biographies from *Famous Men of Rome*, and do some written assignments. Here's how to divide up your work:

Day 1 - Read the textbook and take notes in your history notebook. Put dates on your timeline.

Day 2 - For first assigned FMR biography, do the vocabulary, read, then answer the comprehension questions and do the map work from the student guide.

Day 3 - For the second assigned FMR biography, do the vocabulary and read.

- Do the mapwork from the student guide.
- Instead of doing the comprehension questions, write an interesting story from the biography on the journal pages provided. Be sure to use at least three of the vocabulary words.
- Review and memorize the history dates.

For weeks 3 and 4, you have a choice of 2 journal pages. Use the one that interests you more.

For week 5, you will not be reading from *Famous Men of Rome*. Rather, you will be reading *Colosseum* by E. Mann, and writing a report on it.
