Mater's Birthday Surprise- Adapted Book

These pages and flash cards are for the book *Mater's Birthday Surprise*.



1. Print pages 1- 9 on self-adhesive paper. Cut out the boxes and stick them onto the appropriate pages.
2. Print the flashcards on card stock.
3. I recommend using this book after your child can read the adapted version of *Go, Go, Trucks*. (Free at mercyformarthas.com)
4. Have your child match the word cards to the picture cards. Then pull away the picture cards and have your child select the card you name. Teach them in sets of three-five. Next do a fast flash with those word cards three to five cards, three times in a row. Once your child can successfully read the sight words, he/she is ready to begin reading the adapted version of *Race Team*.
5. When reading the book with your child, the **parent should read any text in grey**. This will help prepare your child for some of the new words he/she is learning and will help with errorless learning. Eventually he/she will be able to read the text in grey.
