

Behind the chair.


The boots are **behind** the chair.

In front of the pillow.


The doll is in front of the pillow.

In front of the lion.


The mouse is in front of the lion.

The comb is **beside** the brush.




Where is the puzzle?

Beside the book.


The puzzle is **beside** the book.
