
On Top Of, Over, and Under



Where is the crown?

On top of the frog.

The crown is **on top of** the frog.



Where is the mouse?

On top of the cheese.


The mouse is **on top of** the cheese.



Where is the frog?

On top of the log.

The frog is on top of the log.



Where is the cake?

On top of the table.

The cake is **on top of** the table.



Where is the fish?

Under the bridge.

The fish is **under** the bridge.



Where is the bug?

Under the shelf.

The bug is under the shelf.



Where are the slippers?

Under the bed.

The slippers are under the bed.



Where is the girl?

Under the blanket.


The girl is **under** the blanket.



Where is the wagon?

Over the hill.

The wagon goes over the hill.



Where is the horse?

Over the fence.

The horse jumps over the fence.



Where is the bird?

Over the tree.

The bird flies over the tree.



Where is the pig?

Over the mud.

The pig jumps over the mud.
