

To prepare the cards:

- 1. Print on card stock and laminate
- 2. The control card is on the left of each page. It is the picture and title *attached*. The cards that number the mysteries (ie. The 1st Joyful Mystery) are separate cards.
- 3. The matching cards are on the right side of each page. Cut so the picture, the title, and the description make separate cards.

There are various ways to use the cards. You can:

- Use the control cards to help your child match picture to picture and/or title to title
- Help your child match title to picture without the control cards
- Help your child read the description cards and match them to the corresponding pictures or control cards.
- Help your child put the pictures in order and label with the cards that number the mysteries

Best of all, when you pray the rosary, you can give your child one card at a time to contemplate during each mystery.
