



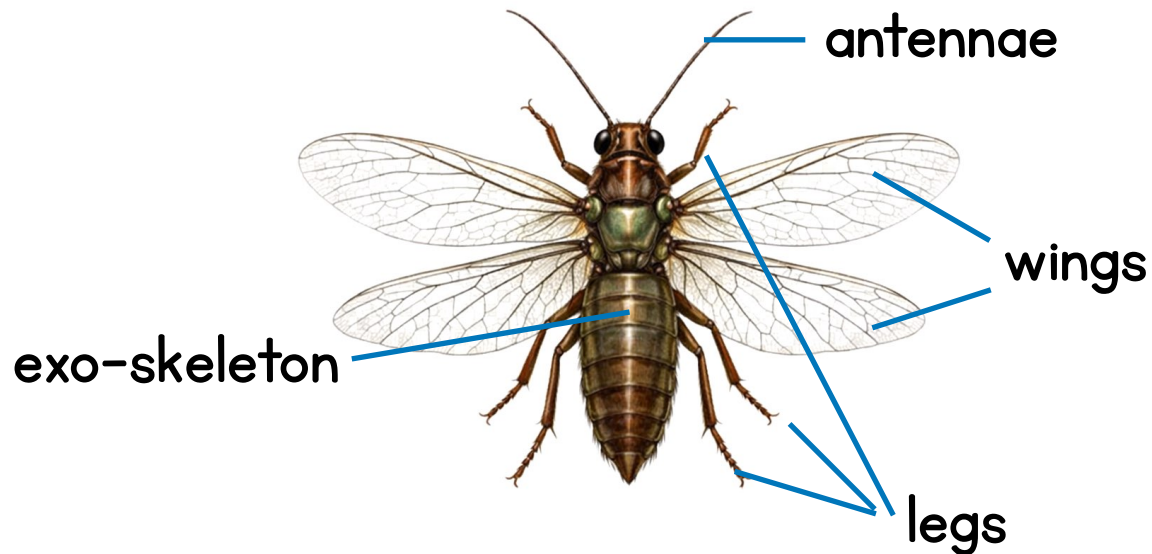

I. What do Insects Look Like?



Insects come in different shapes, sizes, and colors. But they all have **six legs**. They have an outer body called an **exo-skeleton**. Many insects have two pairs of **wings** and one pair of **antennae**. The antennae help them smell, taste, and find their way around.

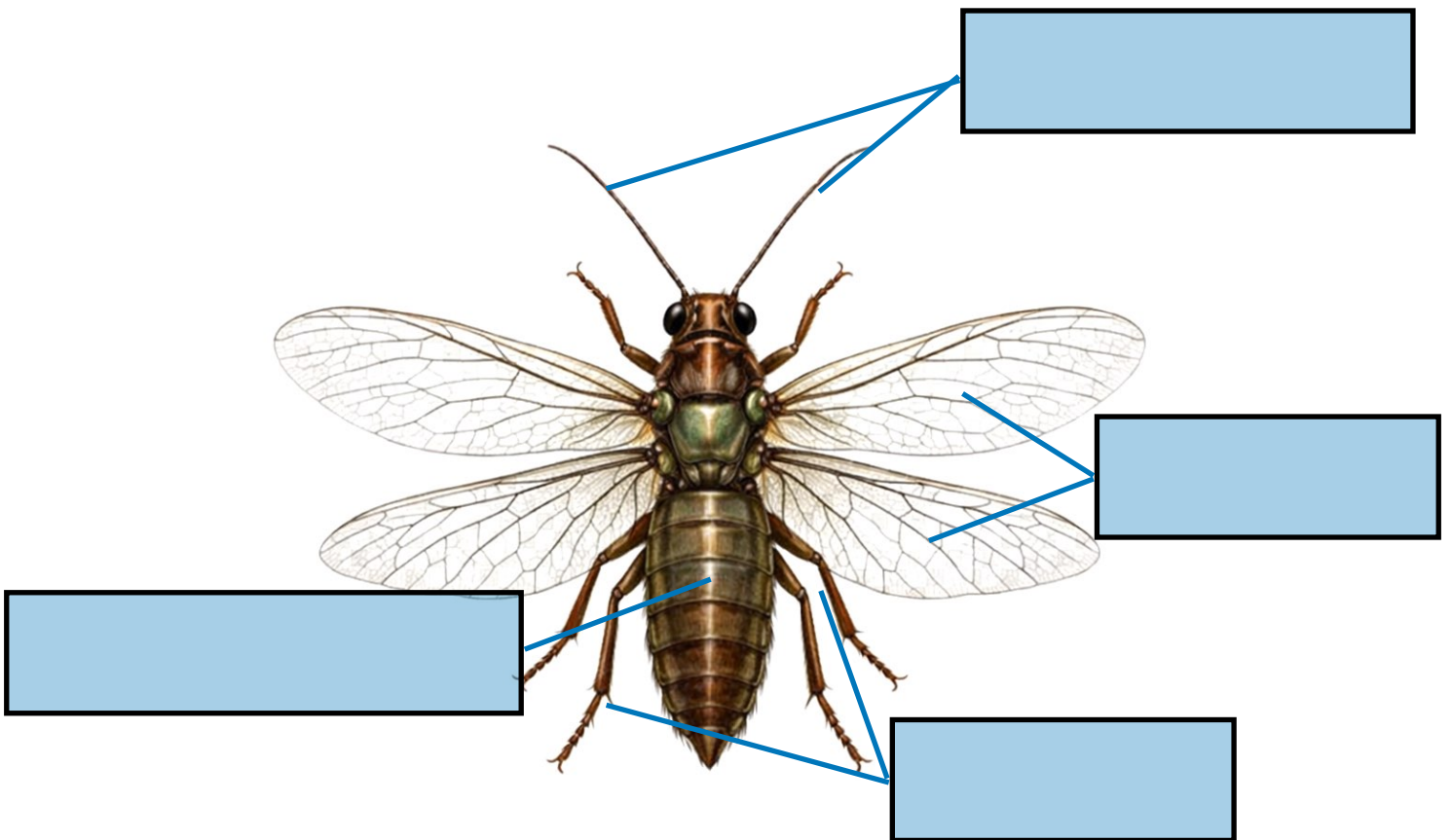

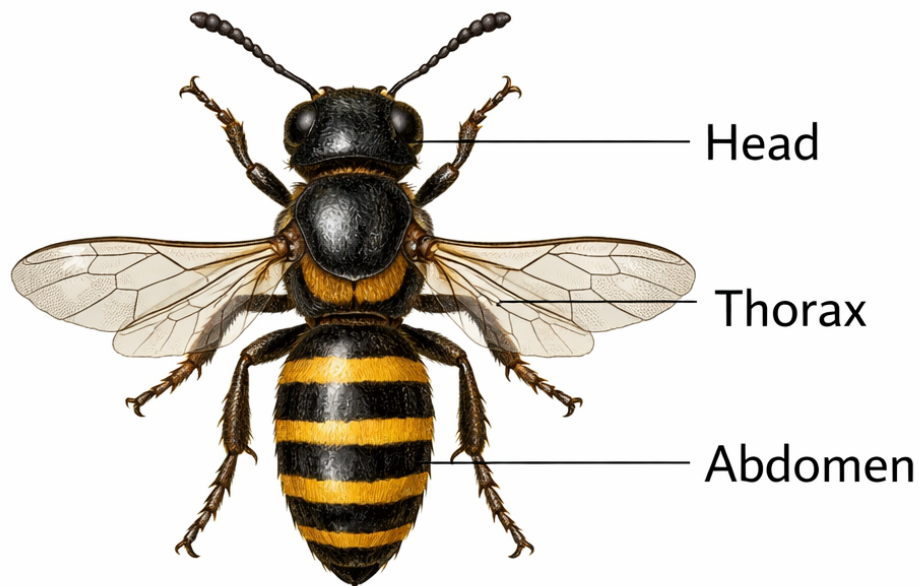

2. The Body Parts of an Insect



All insects have three body parts: the **head**, the **thorax**, and the **abdomen**. All six legs of an insect are attached to the thorax. The abdomen is the back part of an insect's body. It holds important parts like the stomach and tiny holes called **spiracles** that help the insect breathe.

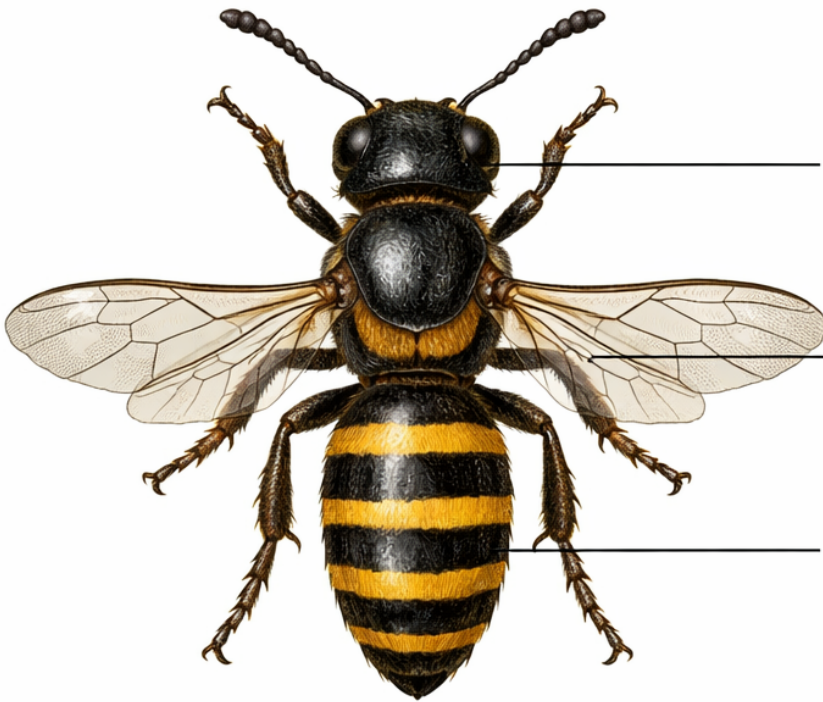
